- 2. Tackling sectarianism: The Committee took evidence from—

Dr Duncan Morrow, Chair of the Advisory Group on Tackling Sectarianism in Scotland, and Dr Michael Rosie, Member of the Advisory Group on Tackling Sectarianism in Scotland, Scottish Government.

- 3. **Tackling sectarianism (in private):** The Committee considered the evidence taken under item 2. It agreed to await the Scottish Government's response to the Advisory Group on Tackling Sectarianism in Scotland's report before taking any further action.
- 4. **Female genital mutilation (in private):** The Committee considered its approach to an inquiry and agreed to seek initial evidence from police, health and education services, before considering its approach further following publication of the Scottish Government's Violence against Women strategy and forthcoming work by the Scottish Refugee Council.
- 5. **Fathers and parenting (in private):** The Committee considered and agreed its approach to forthcoming oral evidence.
