- 1. **Decision on taking business in private:** The Committee agreed to consider its draft Stage 1 report on the Criminal Justice (Scotland) Bill in private today and at future meetings.
- 2. **European Union legislative proposal:** The Committee considered the following European Union legislative proposal which may raise questions in relation to subsidiarity—

Proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the strengthening of certain aspects of the presumption of innocence and of the right to be present at trial in criminal proceedings (COM (2013) 821).

The Committee agreed to write to the relevant Westminster committees highlighting its concerns that the proposals may breach the principle of subsidiarity.

3. **Subordinate legislation:** The Committee considered the following negative instrument—

Act of Sederunt (Fees of Sheriff Officers) 2013 (SSI 2013/345).

The Committee agreed to make no recommendation in relation to the instrument.

4. **Criminal Justice (Scotland) Bill (in private):** The Committee considered a draft Stage 1 report. Various changes were agreed to and the Committee agreed to continue considering the report at its next meeting.

Alison McInnes indicated that she is a member of the Justice Scotland Council.
