- Decisions on taking business in private: The Committee agreed to take items 3 and 4 in private. The Committee also agreed to consider its draft Stage 1 report on the Courts Reform (Scotland) Bill in private at future meetings.
- 2. **Courts Reform (Scotland) Bill:** The Committee took evidence on the Bill at Stage 1 from—

Roseanna Cunningham, Minister for Community Safety and Legal Affairs, Cameron Stewart, Bill Team Leader, and Nicholas Duffy, Solicitor, Legal Directorate, Scottish Government.

The Minister indicated that she is a non-practising member of the Faculty of Advocates. Roderick Campbell indicated that he is a member of the Faculty of Advocates.

- 3. Courts Reform (Scotland) Bill witness expenses (in private): The Committee considered and agreed a witness expenses claim by Sheriff Principal James Taylor.
- 4. **Work programme (in private):** The Committee considered its work programme and agreed to: (a) write to the Cabinet Secretary for Justice seeking an update on issues relating to the Criminal Justice (Scotland) Bill; (b) consider at a future meeting its approach to its consideration of proposals to end the automatic early

release of certain categories of prisoner; (c) undertake visits to the courts to inform its general scrutiny of the Courts Reform (Scotland) Bill; and (d) cancel its meeting on 27 May.
