Local Government and Regeneration Committee Meeting - 8 October 2014

I have been instructed by the Committee to express its disappointment that North Lanarkshire Council was unable to provide a senior official to attend the Committee's meeting on 8 October to provide evidence on the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Bill. This is compounded by the manner and lateness of the withdrawal from appearing.

The Committee has contrasted the approach of North Lanarkshire Council with that of Inverclyde Council whose Chief Executive prioritised attending the Committee over other pressing business. The Committee would welcome a written explanation from your Council covering the failure to attend on 8 October.

The Committee consider it important that the local authority is provided with a further opportunity to consider the matters covered at the meeting.
