- 2. **Bankruptcy (Scotland) Bill:** The Committee considered correspondence from the Scottish Government on the Bill.
- 3. **Bankruptcy (Scotland) Bill:** The Committee took evidence on the Bill at Stage 1 from—

Public Service Vehicles (Registration of Local Services) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2015 (SSI 2015/420).

Act of Sederunt (Sheriff Court Rules Amendment) (Miscellaneous) 2015 (SSI 2015/424);

Welfare Funds (Scotland) Act 2015 (Commencement) Order 2015 (SSI 2015/428 (C.26)).

- 7. **Enterprise Bill (UK Parliament legislation):** The Committee considered the powers to make subordinate legislation conferred on Scottish Ministers in the Enterprise Bill (UK Parliament legislation) and agreed the contents of a report to the Economy, Energy and Tourism Committee.
